For cases requiring air travel outside of Georgia, a flat rate fee of \$2,000.00 is charged, plus \$750.00 for each additional overnight stay for lodging, meals, etc.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancel or reschedule more than 14 days out and no fee applies. Within 14 days, a flat **\$10,000** cancellation fee applies, waived if the matter is rebooked with Judge Brogdon within 90 days and the original date is re-filled.
