The proud son of sharecroppers, Mr. Ware earned his J.D. from the University of Georgia School of Law, where his leadership on the nationally acclaimed moot court team laid the foundation for a successful trial practice. He holds a B.A. in English from the University of West Georgia, earned on academic and athletic scholarships, and is a member of the Blue Key National Honor Society and Phi Eta Sigma.

Admitted to practice before all Georgia state and federal courts and the U.S. Supreme Court, Mr. Ware has represented Fortune 500 companies, municipalities, governmental agencies, insurers, high-profile athletes, and prominent individuals in complex litigation and multimillion-dollar negotiations. - Won a rare federal bench trial in a Fair Housing case brought by a real estate developer related to a multimillion-dollar project
