Ms. Funt brings a rare dual perspective to mediation. She spent five years as an insurance defense attorney at a national law firm representing domestic and international insureds in personal injury, premises liability, negligent security, products liability, commercial, and construction defect matters. She later transitioned to plaintiff-side litigation, where she has handled some of Georgia's most significant catastrophic injury, wrongful death, medical malpractice, constitutional, and government liability cases.

Having worked extensively on both sides of the courtroom, Ms. Funt offers parties a balanced and practical approach to case evaluation, negotiation strategy, and risk assessment. She has taken more than 1,000 depositions and previously taught a Depositions Seminar as an Adjunct Professor at Georgia State University College of Law.

Before entering civil practice, Ms. Funt served as an Assistant Public Defender in Miami-Dade County, where she tried more than twenty-five jury trials as lead counsel in felony matters ranging from drug trafficking to murder. That trial experience gives her a sharp understanding of how cases are evaluated, valued, and resolved, as well as where the true friction points in negotiation often exist.
